

Self Monitoring Policy

The Professional Golfers Career College's Policy for Self Monitoring and Compliance with the BPPE Regulations (5, CCR §71760)

The Professional Golfers Career College (PGCC) is committed to fostering the academic achievement and personal development of its students. To carry out this commitment, the college continuously gathers information about the effectiveness of its academic programs, the progress of students toward educational and personal goals, and the achievements and perspectives of alumni. This information is used to monitor program effectiveness, to recognize educational trends and opportunities, and to develop a sound, factual basis for academic planning. Each student is expected to participate in the school's assessment efforts. The Professional Golf Management Program uses various assessment methods. It shall be the policy of the Professional Golfers Career College to comply with all applicable standards, regulations, rules and laws promulgated by local, state and federal regulators.

To ensure compliance, on an ongoing basis, a subscription to BPPE email notification is sent to the Director of Compliance to ensure that PGCC is current with the BPPE regulations, news and updates. The Director of Compliance also regularly reviews pertinent BPPE laws and regulations that affect the operations of the school. These include the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009, SB Bill 1192, Student Tuition Recovery Fund, Title 5. Division 7.5 and the California Code of Regulations.

At least once per year, the Director of Compliance meets with the President and the Director of Operations to review current BPPE policies and procedures and to highlight any changes. If regulatory changes necessitate adjustment to college operational procedures or documentation, these will be implemented and, if applicable, published in a revised version of the School Catalog.

In instances where BPPE policy and procedural changes must be implemented before the publication of a new catalog, the college will inform staff, students, and faculty, by posting in classrooms and through verbal announcement during class.

PGCC will post School Performance Fact Sheets, and an annual report as required by BPPE as they become available.

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
